Newspaper Article Guidelines

Your article must include:

Headline: An attention getting phrase at the top of the article

Byline: By: Your Name

Lead Paragraph: Start with a strong, interesting sentence to get the reader engaged. Include the who, what, when, where, why and how as it is appropriate.

Newspaper Article Guidelines

Explanation and Amplification: This sections will include several brief paragraphs explaining the main points of the MLK Speech as well as the John Lewis speech. Include a quote from each speaker that best showcases the major point of his speech.

Background Information: This section will include several brief paragraphs explaining events leading up to and including the March on Washington

Newspaper Article Guidelines

Bias: Newspaper articles should be written without bias. You should report the facts objectively. Don't give opinions in your article.

Your article should be at least 1 page and no more than 2.
